

## Pregnant and Parenting Student Modifications

USJ is committed to creating an accessible and inclusive environment for pregnant and parenting students. Students may request adjustments based on general pregnancy needs or accommodations based on a pregnancy related conditions. Temporary adjustments and accommodation requests should be directed to the Accessibility Coordinator. Students who believe they are being harassed or discriminated against because of pregnancy, or that the university is not complying with Title IX requirements covering pregnancy and parenting, should immediately report these concerns to the Title IX Coordinator or any of the deputies. Schools cannot terminate or reduce athletic, merit or need-based scholarships because of pregnancy. The U.S. Education Departments Office for Civil Rights addressed guidelines in the June 2013 Dear Colleague Letter.
