Note on Language Core: Language requirement can be waived with 3 years of one specific language in high school.

Core Perspectives: MWGS (Women/Gender Studies), GI: Global, and VE: Values/Ethics. Each perspective requirement are available with various cores or in major courses.

Sub-discipline requirements beyond POLS 125 include a course in each of: Political Theory, Comparative Politics, and International Relations. 9 credits from law school can transfer back as POLS electives to complete the major and 21 credits transfer back to complete the BA degree. See Law school catalog for required first year courses. The following WNEL courses transferring back to USJ as POLS credits: LAW 500 Intro to Law (1 cr.), LAW 501 Constitutional Law (4 cr.), and LAW 505 Criminal Law (4 cr.)
